Astronomers use maths to work out where to look for stars and how far away they are. Famous astronomer Johannes Kepler even found a new star without having a telescope – just by using maths!

Practice your maths with these starry sums.

For each sum you need to count the number of stars and planets shown on the StarDisc constellation of that name. On StarDisc, the round dots are the stars and planets and each constellation has lines to join up all the stars and planets in it.
